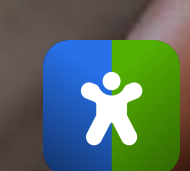




Executive Summary

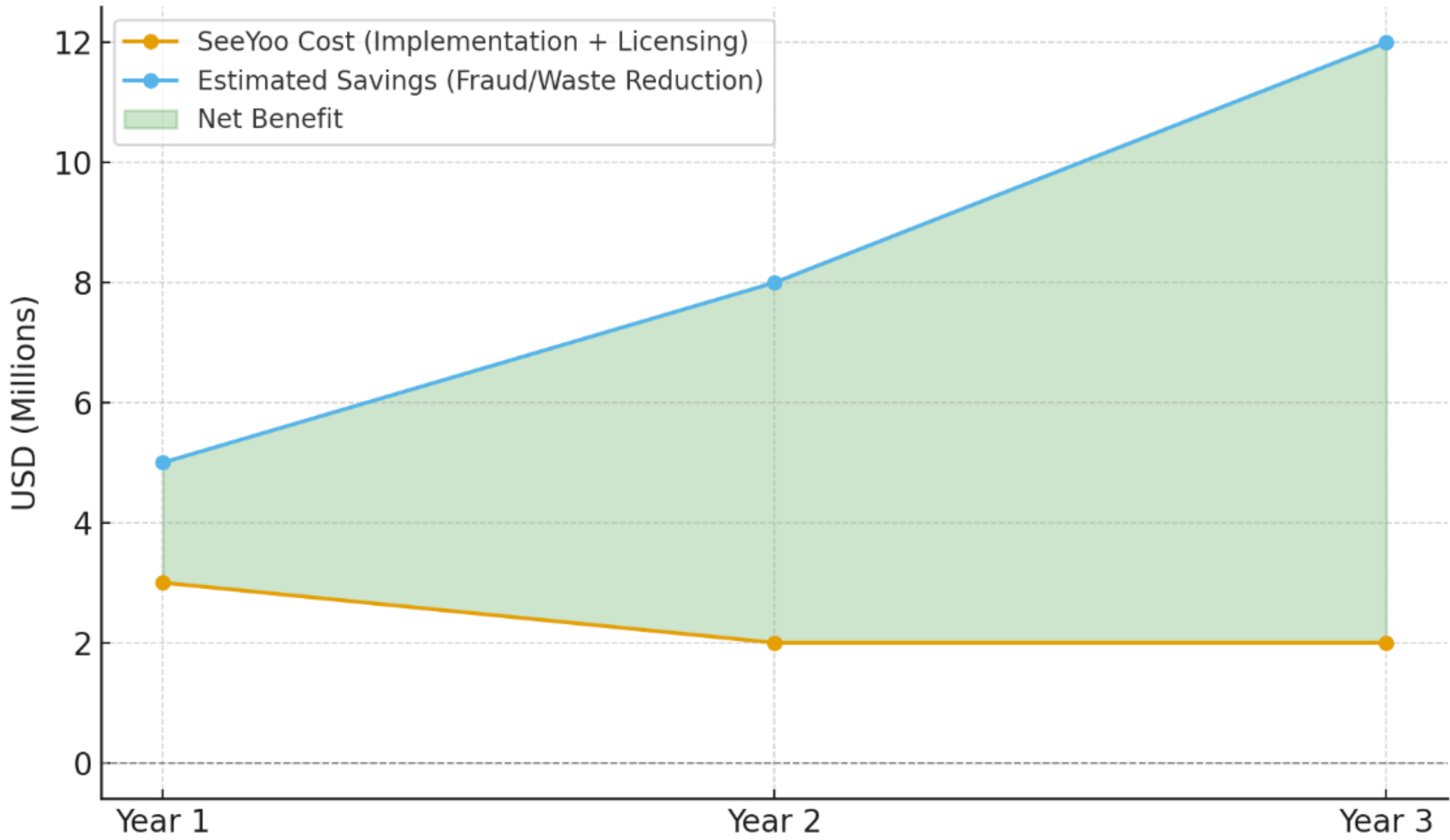

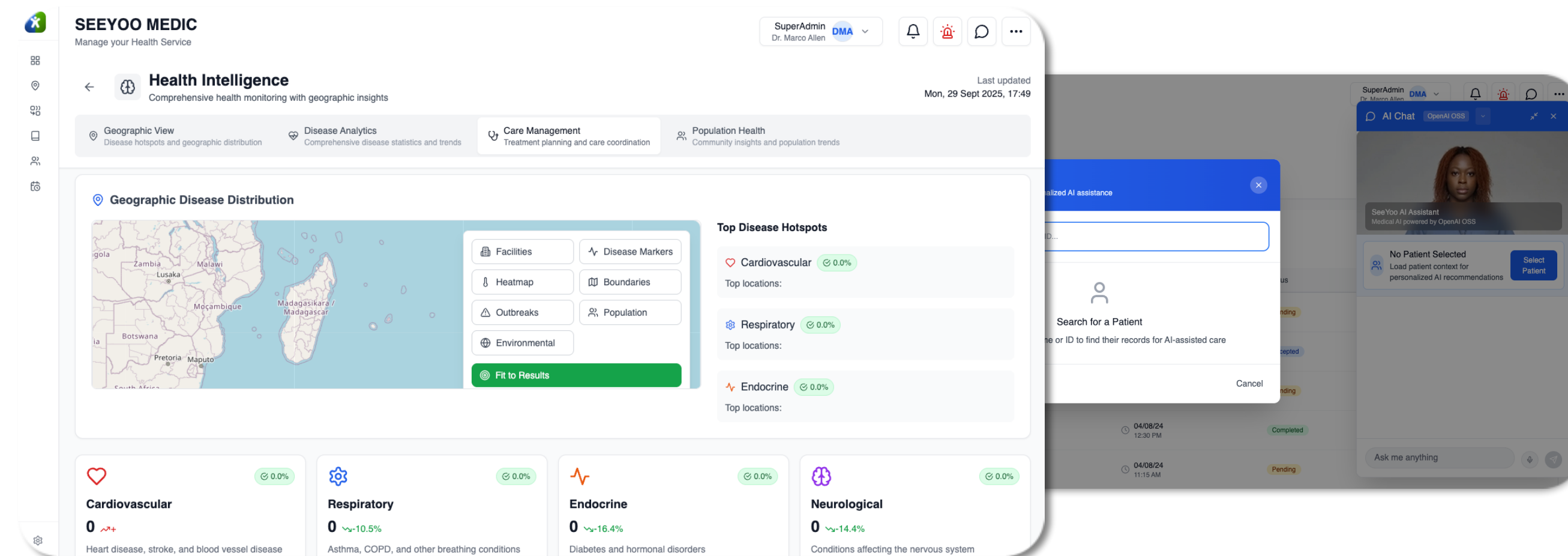

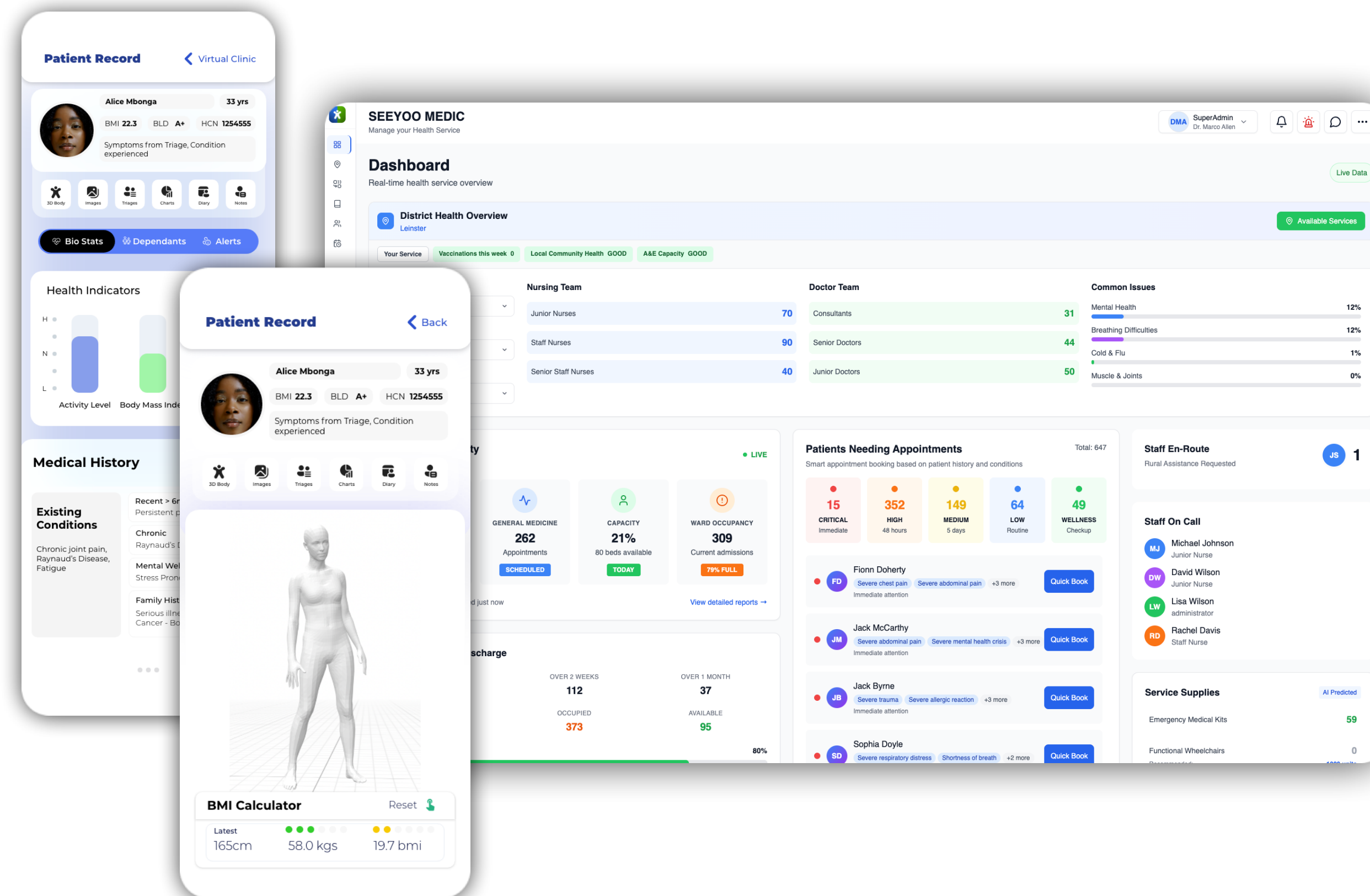
